I N D I C T M E N T

The Grand Jury charges:

On or about September 15, 2006, in the special aircraft jurisdiction of the United States, the defendants, CARL WARREN PERSING and DAWN ELIZABETH SEWELL, did by intimidation, knowingly interfere with the performance of the duties of an aircraft flight attendant and lessen the ability of the attendant to perform his duties, that is, aboard a Southwest Airlines Flight, en route from Los Angeles, California, to Raleigh-Durham, North Carolina, with a stop in Phoenix, Arizona, the defendants repeatedly engaged in overt sexual activity in the cabin of the plane to such an extent that the flight attendant had to direct them to stop, and did threaten to initiate a violent confrontation with the flight attendant, and did otherwise interfere with the flight attendant, and did aid and abet each other in doing so, in violation of Title




